

The city is situated on the banks of the Turia, on the east coast of the Iberian Peninsula, fronting the Gulf of Valencia on the Mediterranean Sea. Its historic centre is one of the largest in Spain, with approximately 169 ha (420 acres);[4] this heritage of ancient monuments, views and cultural attractions makes Valencia one of the country's most popular tourist destinations. Due to its long history, this is a city with numerous popular celebrations and traditions, such as the Fallas (featuring the traditional Spanish dish paella), which were declared as Fiestas of National Tourist Interest of Spain in 1965[5] and Intangible cultural heritage by UNESCO in November 2016. From 1991 to 2015, Rita Barber[6] Nolla was the mayor of the city, yet in 2015, Joan Rib[7] from Coalici[8] Comprom[9]s, became mayor.
