CONFERENCE OBJECTIVES:

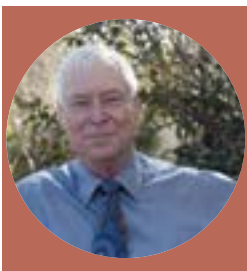
- To facilitate opportunities for networking, collaboration and exchange of ideas with internationally renowned leaders in Global Warming research and development.

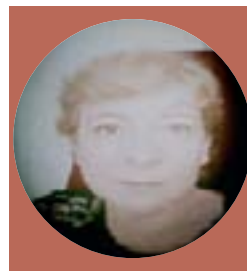

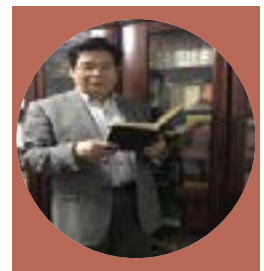

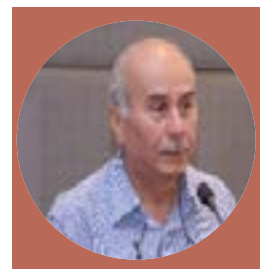
